Virgo hamna

At the gateway to the North Pole, this place rich in history was once a port of departure for many expeditions but also for whalers. The strategic position of the site and its history give it a unique character in the region. It is an unmissable stopover and only possible for small groups of people. Walruses and harbor seals can sometimes be seen.

Smeerenburg & Fair Haven

This is where William Barrent first discovered the existence of Svalbard. A favorite region of whalers and still today of cetaceans, it also offers a diversity of landscapes that makes it very attractive. It is also one of the rare places where you can observe common seals (especially towards Sally Hamna or Virgo Hamna). It is also a place of passage and hunting appreciated by bears.

Kongsfjord

Kongsfjord is one of the richest and most beautiful fjords in the whole archipelago. Scientists have chosen it to establish the Ny-Alesund research station because of its particularity and diversity in fauna, flora and glaciology.

You will indeed be able to observe a geological diversity like the pyramidal forms of the summits of the 3 crowns or the point of Kvadehuken or the cavities of basalts of Blomsteroya.

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Sally Hamna

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Raudfjord

Hamiltonbukta was born from the retraction of a glacier which revealed a labyrinth of islands in which one can easily circulate by zodiac. On the edge of this old glacier, a bird cliff. A little further in the fjord, several hiking sites.

Wood and Liefdefjord

Word for word «love fjord», this is an unmissable stopover near the Monaco glacier to observe its deep blue. Around Texas Bar, the Andoya Islands offer many opportunities for wildlife observation.

The Mushamna lagoon is also worth the detour, often very popular with belugas, bears and reindeer. You can also visit a trapper's cabin!

Fives miles lake

This place is not very well known and not very accessible because it does not always appear on the maps! It is the only canyon in Svalbard! You can go up to the inner lake and glacier at the source by a hike of about 2 hours. It is a unique and preserved place, the tundra is luxuriant.

Hinlopen

The Hinlopen Strait separates the two largest islands of the archipelago: Spitzbergen and Nordaustlandet. It is occupied in a variable way by the ice at this period and we will try to reach it to observe the fauna which migrates from the West to the East by the ice occupying the strait. According to the possibilities we will go to some remarkable sites of the strait.

Many cetaceans pass through the currents of the strait and the navigation is scenic.

Trygga hamna

At the entrance of the Isfjord, this bay is particularly known for its cliffs and for the biological diversity that it hosts. We often find different kinds of animals and the beach often allows to approach easily to observe them better.

Bellsund

Located in the south-western part, Bellsund is one of the places of this coast where the ice of fjord remains until late in the year. It is an ideal place to hunt for bears and is a simple migration route for them to go from the West to the East.

Although they do not have a sedentary environment, belugas are also found quite often near the shores of this fjord.

Hornsund

This fjord shelters the highest peaks of the archipelago. It is also known for the bays covered with glaciers. Some consider it the most beautiful fjord of the archipelago. Its reliefs offer superb points of view. It is also the shortest way to reach the west and the east by land and therefore a favorite migration route for bears.

7 islands

The northernmost archipelago in the world. These islands are home to a lot of wildlife that sits there in a privileged way with easy and quick access to the ice. Walruses, bears and polar foxes are often found here. From here you can see the North of Spitzberg and its peaks.

Brasevlbreen & Isisbukta

180 km long, it is the largest glacier front in Europe and Austfonna the 3rd largest ice cap in the world. Navigation along the front will offer you an unforgettable panorama by inviting you to observe the changes in the structure and colour of the ice. Depending on the period, waterfalls emanating from the rivers of the glacier can be observed on the western part. The eastern part is emerging and creates many icebergs that drift in the area.

Storoya

This island, located to the east of Nordaustlandet, is partly covered by an ice cap. Many walrus colonies live here and it is also a hunting ground for bears.

Karl XII

This island with its singular shape is inaccessible but offers unique rock structures and an exceptional place for bears to spend the summer. At the same time close to the ice but on land, it is an ideal compromise to wait for the return of winter. In the middle of the sea, it gives the feeling of arriving on a mysterious newly discovered island.

Depending on the nautical configuration, you have to dial to take one or the other in order to access the south-eastern part of Spitzberg. Storfjord "grand fjord" is the widest of the archipelago, the cetaceans find many food sources and here you will see the largest icebergs in the northern area. Some do several Km of nevergure! Kongfjord

The Kongfjord is one of the richest and most beautiful fjords in the whole archipelago. Scientists chose it to establish the Ny-Alesund research station because of its particularity and diversity in fauna, flora and glaciology.

You will indeed be able to observe a geological diversity such as the pyramidal shapes of the summits of the 3 crowns or the point of Kvadehuken or the basalt cavities of Blomsteroya.

The glaciers all have their specificity and illustrate different stages of formation and you will be able to observe large icebergs in various colors that have washed up in the bottom of the fjord.

The fauna is also fond of this place in which it is not uncommon to observe: birds, reindeer, polar foxes and bears.

History has housed several attempts to exploit the wealth of this land such as the New London Marble quarry, the ruins of which remain accessible.

Magdalenefjorden

The bay of the madeleine has something poetic with its handle which, like a natural port, protects against the vagaries of the weather. You can observe imposing glaciers, often a source of food for walruses. It is a site that lends itself very well to hiking too.

Trygga hamna

At the entrance to the Isfjord, this bay is particularly known for its cliffs and for the biological diversity it hosts. There are often different kinds of animals there and the beach often makes it easy to approach them to better observe them.

Arctic polar sea ice navigation

Crossing from Svalbard to Greenland to meet the Arctic polar pack ice. A route worthy of explorers with possible encounters with bears on ice.

Great East Greenland navigation

Franz Joseph

Franz Joseph and KOng Oscar Fjord are part of the large North East nature reserve and are exceptionally wild and protected areas, with very limited access.

Rode Fjord

Known for its red rocks which contrast with the blue of gigantic drifting icebergs. An unmissable stopover.

Hall Bredning

This bay is known for the gigantic icebergs it hosts. A real slalom among shapeshifting ice giants. A journey into a world of ice.

Ittoqqortoormiit

The most remote village of any civilization and the closest to the great park of eastern greenland. The community living there lives mainly from fishing and hunting. A unique opportunity to perceive the cultural life in the wildest part of Greenland.

Hekla Haven

Named after the expedition ship used by Carl Ryder during the exploration of Northeast Greenland from 1891-92. Along with the remains of the expedition hut are older Inuit remains, as well as great tundra walks, wildlife, and exceptional geology.

Fohnfjord

Steep-sided basalt fjord on the south side of Milneland. Some cliffs rise to more than 2000 meters.

Harefjord

It is one of the most densely vegetated parts of the fjord. Also a popular place for musk oxen and other types of mammals and polar birds. It is a place that lends itself perfectly to walking and which allows you to have breathtaking views of the fjord and its icebergs.

Øfjord and bear Island (Jytteshavn)

One of the most spectacular sites in Scoresby sund with its granite cliffs. The channel between Bear Island, which as its name suggests is a favorite place for polar bears, and Milne Land, gives a superb view and opening onto the fjord. A walk to Jytteshavn is highly recommended for the views. Especially at sunset.



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

Explore this f rozen, wild and fascinating continent aboard the Perseverance. Terra Incognita where the ice plays with multiple reflections and nature offers you a breathtaking spectacle. A timeless escape into limitless immensity.

Admire the whales from the outside deck, witness the life of penguins and their predators, killer whales, seals, leopards and other marine mammals. Listen to the resounding roar of seracs in emblematic passages, marvel at the majestic icebergs and glaciers that make this navigation a discovery imbued with emotion and nature.

Our guides will accompany you to make you relive the rich history of this white paradise for a long time coveted for its riches. The polar magic will carry you away in this highly emotional contemplation.

To get there, you will have to earn the emblematic passage of the Drake south of Cape Horn. A step shared by explorers throughout history, giving access to the white continent.

Possible stopover points:

- Deception Island (South Shetland Islands) with its bay protected from winds and swells and its warm waters due to its still active volcano. A former whaling station, it is accessed by the forges of Neptune. a polar bath will be offered to you.
- Half moon Island is home to a colony of gentoo penguins and is a nesting ground for arctic terns and kelp gulls. Whales are often seen here off the shore.
- Neko Harbor, grau on Andvord Bay, one of the most beautiful bays on the peninsula, surrounded by glaciers. The fauna is abundant and exceptional.
- Port Lockroy (Goudier Island), historic site of a former weather station transformed into a post office. Open to the public and composed of a museum and a souvenir shop, you can observe gentoo penguins there.
- Canal Lemaire known for the splendor of its steep cliffs that border the passage filled with icebergs. Picturesque with protected waters as calm as a lake, a rare event in these seas.
- Brown Bluff and its singular volcanic geology with its breathtaking volcanic tuff cliff, its penguins and snow petrels.
- Trinity Island (Palmer Archipelago) where you will discover many shipwrecks as well as whale bones. A very active colony of gentoos is present, and fur seals like to bask in the sun.
- Weddell Sea and its majestic tabular icebergs.

If the weather and the sea allow us, we may have the opportunity to cross the legendary Cape Horn. The southernmost point of the lands attached to North America, at the south end of Tierra del Fuego. A 425 m high cliff, located on an island in Chilean territorial waters, Cape Horn marks the northern limit of the Drake Passage, and the meridian that crosses it defines, from the cape to Antarctica, the border between the Pacific Ocean and the Atlantic Ocean.


